

THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON

BY-LAW NO. 57-21

A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 68-20 AND TO ESTABLISH 2022 FEES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 5 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended (hereinafter the *Municipal Act, 2001*), the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by its council and a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it, for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board, and for the use of its property including property under its control;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 69(1) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, the council of a municipality may by by-law establish a tariff of fees for the processing of applications made in respect of planning matters;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 4 of the *Health Protection and Promotion Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.7, as amended, the Board of Health shall superintend, provide or ensure the provisions of the health program and services required by this Act and the regulations to the persons who reside in the health unit;

AND WHEREAS The Regional Municipality of Halton (hereinafter referred to as the Regional Corporation) passed By-law No. 68-20 on the 16th day of December, 2020;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Corporation provides certain services to the public, the local municipalities and to various government and outside agencies;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Regional Corporation has determined that wherever feasible, the total cost of any such services provided by the Regional Corporation shall be recovered by the Regional Corporation;

AND WHEREAS, in response to the Royal Canadian Mint no longer distributing pennies as of February 4, 2013 and pennies being gradually withdrawn from circulation, the Council of the Regional Corporation is desirous of following the Government of Canada's rounding guidelines for cash transactions;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Regional Corporation is desirous of establishing fees and charges for 2022 to recover the total cost of services provided by the Regional Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the 2022 fees and charges as specified in Schedule "A" to this By-law, which Schedule is made a part hereof, shall on or after the 1st day of January, 2022, be charged by the Regional Corporation for those services or activities, or for the use of its property provided by the Regional Corporation, as specified in Schedule "A" to this By-law.
2. THAT By-law No. 68-20 is hereby repealed effective the 1st day of January, 2022.
